Q1. *What is the first step in applying for PROCESS?*

A1. If you are interested in PROCESS, the first step is to complete a registration of interest form on our website at <https://www.process-cofund.eu/how-to-apply/register-interest>. Here you will provide your contact details and a brief abstract. This will help the PROCESS team to assess whether your proposal aligns to the PROCESS research programme and assist you in identifying an appropriate academic supervisor.

Q2. *What are the official start dates for PROCESS fellowships?*

A2. Fellowships for Call 1 will start 1 October 2019. Fellowships for Call 2 will start 1 October 2020.

Q3. *How to I obtain support from my non-academic supervisor for the industry secondment?*

A3. Academic supervisors should coordinate engagement with potential non-academic supervisors and obtain letters of support on behalf of the candidate. The letters should be on company/organisation letterhead and signed by the proposed supervisor.

Q4. *When will interviews be held?*

A4. Interviews will be held in the University of Limerick end-May through mid-June 2019 for Call 1. Applicants shortlisted for interview will receive notification of interview date no later than May 10. Interviews may be conducted remotely using SkypeforBusiness or similar application, if required. It will be the responsibility of applicants to organise access to remote telecom/internet facilities.

Q5. *I'm not a citizen of a European country. Can I apply to PROCESS?*

A5. Researchers are welcome from any EU member state, associated country, overseas country or territory linked to EU member states, or associated third countries. If you are unsure about the status of your state, please contact the PROCESS PM (Kristy.butler@ul.ie) to seek clarification.
